Dear General Mortensen:

Please let me introduce myself, my name is Brad Giordani and I am the President of Militec, Inc located in Waldorf Maryland. Since 1988, my company has produced a Synthetic Weapons Lubricant; called MILITEC-1 that has been in constant demand by our Soldiers since OEF began.

The reason for my correspondence is that recently we were exhibiting at the Government Security Exposition in Washington, where I was demonstrating MILITEC-1 to Lieutenant General XXX.
